

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR INTAKE CARD

DATE - Date the bird was rescued

SPECIES – Type of bird that was rescued

ADMISSION # - This equals the date that the bird was rescued + the code for the type of bird rescued. (See - Codes for table 5, raptors) (i.e. 09162017-RTHA-01). The last 2 digits are usually always 01 but if we got in, for example, 2 RTHA on the same day we need a way to identify who is who. So the 2<sup>nd</sup> one would be 09162017-RTHA-02

SHRR VOLUNTEER – Person who rescued the bird. Could be 2 or more people if we had “hand offs” in transporting, but generally the 1<sup>st</sup> person who picked up the bird is responsible for completing this card and their name noted here.

NAME, ADDRESS, PHONE # AND COUNTY – Who called in the bird and their phone number and the address and county of where the bird was picked up. Sometimes the caller has met us with a bird. But we need the address of where the “bird” was picked up not where we met someone.

If possible do they want the bird back where it came from? Yes or no

DONATION – Sometimes folks will give us money on the spot for the care of the bird or as a general donation. Indicate the \$ amount here and give the money to the person you are taking the bird to.

PRESENTING CONDITION – After doing your field examination the suspected injuries would be listed here.

The remaining portion of the card would be completed by the person receiving the bird
